The event will take place on Friday, October 22, at Spanish Wells Golf & Country Club in Bonita Springs. The Champion of the Year Gala will celebrate the efforts of 14 philanthropic leaders from Southwest Florida while partying with a purpose to raise funds for Best Buddies programs. The gala will feature a silent and live auction, dinner, cocktails, dancing, a keynote address from a Best Buddies buddy pair and a special awards ceremony. This year's Champion of the Year Gala will raise funds to expand the programs offered for students and adults with and without intellectual and developmental disabilities. Corey Lazar, morning anchor of WINK News, will serve as emcee with Rick Gallo as auctioneer.
