Expanded VA COVID-19 Vaccine Availability – SAVE LIVES Act Calling all Veterans, their spouses, and caregivers

April 8 2021 – The West Palm Beach VA (WPBVA) is now able to provide COVID-19 vaccines to all Veterans, their spouses and caregivers, and some beneficiaries ahead of the projected May 1 start date.

WPBVA is offering vaccines to the following groups who are eligible for a COVID-19 vaccine at VA:



- Veterans, regardless of discharge
- Spouse of a Veteran
- Caregivers of a Veteran (For COVID-19 vaccine eligibility, a caregiver is as a family member/friend who provides care to a Veteran – Examples include helping a Veteran with personal needs like feeding, bathing, dressing or with tasks like shopping or transportation)
- Recipients of Civilian Health and Medical Program of the Department of Veterans Affairs (CHAMPVA) benefits

With these additional groups, VA can now vaccinate more than 30 million individuals!
