The Palm Beach Health Network is Expanding to the Treasure Coast



The new Florida Coast Health Network will provide high-quality care to the residents of Martin and St. Lucie Counties

"With the future opening of the Florida Coast Health Network, we will be able to create a stronger healthcare infrastructure with high-quality care for the Treasure Coast community."

The Florida Coast Health Network announcement comes on the heels of Palm Beach Health Network's recent \$150 million investment toward acquiring state-of-the-art technology, improving infrastructure, enhancing patients' experiences, clinical resources, and continuing education programs.
