- 3-day trial period
- Ability to pass the designated healthcare facility employability screenings prior to the start of trial period

- Performing basic data entry into Word, Excel, and healthcare software systems, scanning/copying documents
- Reading and fulfilling orders, distributing healthcare materials to various departments
